(The Following outline is intended to provide inspiration for the role your involvement at Oaks Barn Farm and its opportunities for all)

Principal Responsibilities:

1. To prepare and implement a seasonal plan of planting.
2. To provide the farm, its guests and volunteers with a selection of seasonal fruit and Vegetables.
3. Develop a 4 year crop rotation plan for the Kitchen Garden & Poly Tunnel
4. Actively develop our Recycle Re Use strategy in all of our practice
5. To develop in conjunction with the farmer a programme for kitchen garden volunteers to participate enjoy and harvest

Other duties may include but are not limited to:

- a. To develop succession planting to provide continuous cropping throughout the year
- b. Undertake responsibility for converting our orchard crop into Cider, fruit juice Wine Etc.
- c. Harvesting seed for next year's sowing
- d. Maintaining automatic irrigation
- e. Assist in fence maintenance
- f. Foster guest experience
- g. Assist with livestock under the direction of the farmer
- h. Assist with Lambing
- i. Participate in Tree Planting for our woodland project
- j. Enhance our wildlife habitat throughout the farm
- k. To make use of Foraging opportunities as the seasons provide including Elderflower, Sloes, black berries, crab apples, mushrooms, Jack of the hedgerow
- l. Develop Farm Stall for selling off excess produce using the funds raised to support future projects
- m. To support Volunteers to the site by providing them with an opportunity to grow
